Visiting session by families/keepers of clients from National Anti-drugs Agency (NADA) who are now currently following Treatment and Rehabilitation Program in Narcotics Addiction Rehabilitation Centres (PUSPEN) within this entire country is now allowed.

This family visit will create space and chance for families/keepers and clients to meet again as well as a therapeutic approach in supporting clients within this institution to keep on giving their best commitments in rehabilitation.

The permission of the visit has to oblige with the standard operational procedure (SOP) that has been set. Each families/keepers will be required to arrange an appointment with PUSPEN's staffs to avoid any traffic, ensuring NADA's service runs smoothly and to prevent any risk of Covid-19 virus' spreading.

The appointment's application can be done via phone calls; short-message-service (SMS), *WhatsApp* application; letters or e-mails to Rehabilitation Officer involved.
